

Later on, you will proceed to visit Temple of Luxor, which was built by one of the kings of the 12th dynasty and completed by the well know king Ramses II. This temple was located in the heart of ancient Thebes and, like Karnak, was dedicated to the main/chief god Amun Re.

Day 06: Visit Edfu & Koum Oumbo Temples - Sail to Aswan - Nile Cruise Overnight.



The first temple (the biggest one) was built by Ramesses II and being dedicated to the famous god Rahorakhty. While the second temple (the smaller one) was dedicated to king himself and his beautiful wife queen Nefertari.
- → After finishing your day tour, you will drive back toward Aswan (distance takes approx. 03 hrs by car) and then to Aswan Airport


